Is SFG20 is a web based?

Yes, it is. SFG20 content changes on a continuous basis, so to access the latest information you access it via the customer login section on SFG20.co.uk

How about those Sub Contractors that do not agree with budgets being allocated in a 70:30 ratio (planned to reactive) what will be the action for that?

The risk is that by relying more on a reactive approach, assets are not efficiently maintained, cost more to run and are less likely to last their full intended design life, this contributes to the vicious cycle of reactive maintenance that we discussed in the webinar. Best practice is for planned maintenance to form the bedrock of your maintenance regime.

What about small reactive jobs? and quotes request?

SFG20 is not a CAFM system, rather the contents that can integrate with third party software to provide task instructions for teams to complete

How do BESA intend to better inform end user clients / Building owners that the contents of SFG20 is a guidance standard that is based upon a shopping list of recommendations that the user should configure to their own individual circumstances?

I have found in various employments that end-user clients are ill-informed and interpret that the maintenance service provider must undertake everything noted within the SFG20 Task schedules. What are BESA's views on the hidden costs of over-maintenance and the risks associated with un-necessary maintenance intervention?

SFG20 advocate blending maintenance approaches to optimise their maintenance regime. Would you expect the PPM/reactive ratio to change where PPM isn't carried out (i.e. more towards a 50/50)?

Yes, we would expect the amount of money spent on reactive maintenance to increase when planned preventation maintenance decreases. By how much would depend on the assets' condition, servicing history, usage levels etc.

Would you consider creating a set of service-reports that contractors could use to evidence accomplishment. A sort of check list for all tasks applicable, followed by name signature and date.

Is it possible to send the scientific document by email?

Content can be shared within a company with an SFG20 license via pdf download. Xml download is also available to input SFG20 content into CAFM and other third-party software systems.

Does the Resource Modeller anticipate efficiencies previously mentioned in point 10? (grouping tasks to reduce site visits)

SFG20 is fully customisable and allows users to run multiple scenarios to create comparisons.

Do you have a list of the essential data that is required to enable the model to work, you mentioned rate, size of floor area etc.

Sure! We hope the steps below give you an overview of the information inputs. Note: There is data already in the module to select from e.g., regions via a dropdown menu. In addition, there are preset rates in the module (which can be amended) for skillset hourly rates, and overhead %s.

- 1. Input Building Details
- 2. Including region and gross internal floor area (GIFA).
- 3. Select appropriate Schedules
- 4. Select schedules based on the assets at a location.
- 5. Amend Model Quantities & Out-of-Hours Working
- 6. Amend task frequencies and out-of-hours rates as required.
- 7. Adjust Hourly Rates & Input Specialist Costs
- 8. Review and update rates against skillsets for standard time and region if needed.
- 9. Adjust Variables
- 10. Annualised maintenance cost plan created. Adjust variables by amending default percentages.
- 11. Resource Model Summary



12. Summary of your annualised resource/cost profile for PPM activities.

How often are new maintenance tasks introduced?

We update maintenance tasks according to new or changing legislation or regulation. We also introduce new maintenance tasks when legislation and regulation requires it. We send out a monthly technical bulletin to users to report all of the updates and changes and we reference which piece(s) of legislation has driven the change.

What is the cost structure for this software?
